EA Holding wins RM6.6m contract from LHDNM

ONE-STOP Information and communication technology (ICT) provider EA Holdings Bhd has secured a RM6.6 million contract for data centre relocation from the Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia (LHDNM).

The job will be undertaken by its subsidiary EASS Sdn Bhd. The relocation involving migration of data centre from Jalan Duta to Cyberjaya is ongoing and expected to complete by Dec 3, 2014.

The offical contract between EA Holdings and LHDNM was signed on Tuesday. "The signing will further enhance our

operations and we are expecting EA Holdings' revenue for 2012 to increase by 20%," said EA Holdings chief executive officer Mohammad Sobri Saad at the signing ceremony.

In addition to the contract, EA Holdings has tendered for numerous projects with government bodies and government-linked companies (GLCs), estimated to be worth around RM100 million in total, of which the company is confident of winning a few, towards sustaining the company's future.

The group also secured another project worth RM8 million from Lembaga Zakat Selangor for its ICT Core System.
